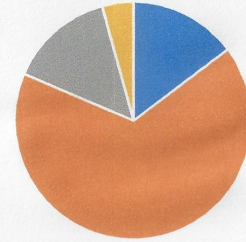

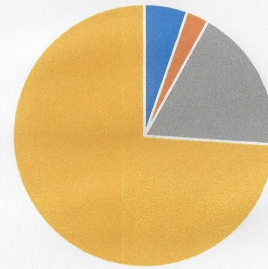
Year ended December 31, 2020
